



Effective 4th June 2021, the Government of Sri Lanka has restricted passengers who have been to / via India, Vietnam, South Africa and 14 South American countries within the last 14 days to enter Sri Lankan airports until further notice.

Airlines are authorized to carry per flight 75 Sri Lankans, Dual Citizens, Seafarers, Business Travelers, Investors etc.

Tourist visiting Sri Lanka do not require any approvals, please visit the Sri Lanka Tourism for direction at <http://www.srilanka.travel/helloagain/>

All inbound travelers should be mandatorily quarantined at a Quarantine Hotel/Quarantine Centre/Safe and Secure Certified Level 1 Hotel until completion of 14 days as per the guidelines of the Director General of Health Services dated 11th May 2021, irrespective to the type / number of doses of vaccine obtained.

Sri Lankan passport holders and Dual Citizens do not require approvals to land in Sri Lanka. Seafarers, Business Travelers, Investors etc. require the approvals from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Civil Aviation Authority to enter Sri Lanka along with the entry visa. Foreign passport holders visiting friends, family and attending to personal business matters require approvals from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Civil Aviation Authority and obtain appropriate visas.

A negative PCR test must be obtained by all categories of travelers prior to departure point of origin as per airline/country requirements. All passengers must adhere to the paid quarantine procedure upon arrival in Sri Lanka.
